



Anna Fennick Proctor

May 6, 1918 - August 1, 2012

Anna Marie Fennick Proctor passed away Wednesday, August 1, 2012 at Natchez Community Hospital after a very brief hospitalization.

A memorial service reflecting upon her 94 years of life, love and many wonderful friendships will be held at Calvary Baptist Church, 2001 Murray Drive, Vidalia, on Tuesday, August 7, 2012 at 11:00.

Anna was born May 6, 1918 in Wilkes-Barre, PA, daughter of John P. and Anna Sabo Fennick. Her parents were first generation Americans from Austria-Hungary. Anna married Luther H. (L.H.) Proctor on August 6, 1943 in Yuma, AZ. He preceded her in death on March 17, 1998 after fifty-four years of loving marriage.

Surviving is her son Lawrence H. Proctor, her daughter-in-law Cassandra H. Proctor and her grandson John A. Proctor, all of St. Johns, MI.

Anna loved to travel with L.H. visiting all 50 of the United States, most of the Canadian provinces and a few of the States in Mexico. Much of their traveling was done in their silver home away from home Airstream. Yet as much as she loved to travel, coming home to friends and family always was important to her. She loved her little home and all of her friends in the Natchez and Vidalia (Miss-Lou) area. She was an active volunteer at Natchez Community Hospital

and truly missed the time she spent there with the hospital staff and volunteers. Her relationship with the hospital became more meaningful after she successfully beat breast cancer sixteen years ago. Anna was fiercely independent and truly valued being able to live on her own and to be able to maintain her wealth of social activities even after the death of her one true love, Luther. She also truly cherished her family in Michigan, especially her grandson John, who was the apple of her eye.
