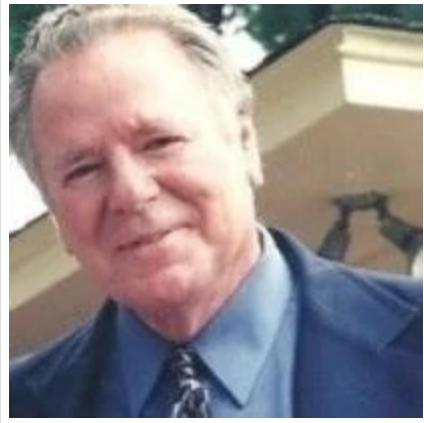




Barry K. Hamilton Sr.
