Funeral services for Carmon Walker, 69, of Jonesville, LA will be held at The First Baptist Church of Jonesville on Wednesday, January 16, 2013 at 2:00 PM with Dr. Ralph Webber and Rev. Carmon Walker was born on October 23, 1943 in Nebo, LA, and passed away Sunday, January 13, 2013 at Grace Home in Alexandria. He was a resident of Jonesville and an active member and Senior Deacon of the First Baptist Church of Jonesville. Carmon received his undergraduate degree from LSU and later received his Masters in Education Supervision, from the University of Southern Mississippi. Upon graduation from LSU he went on to be the basketball and football coach for Vidalia High School. He later became the Business Manager for Catahoula School Systems. He worked as General Manager for Norman Haigh, with Haigh Farms. He then was elected for the office of Tax Assessor in Catahoula Parish, serving seven terms, six of which he ran un-opposed, and recently retired from that position.

He was preceded in death by his father, Charlie Floyd Walker.
