Dwight Edwards, 70, passed away in his sleep at his residence at Larto Lake on Saturday, January 18, 2020. Dwight is preceded in death by his father Lawrence Desmond Edwards, Sr.; mother Iola Yvonne White Edwards; mother-in-law Francis Cotherman Ford; and sister Gloria Jeannette Sanders.

Dwight was a graduate of Central High School in Larto, and Northeast State University (ULM) in Monroe, LA. Dwight worked in the oil field industry in safety and compliance; and also served as a teacher.
