Mr. Greer was also very active in his community as a member of The Loyal Order Moose and Retired Officers Association of the Natchez Lodge for 20 years, he was a 26 year member and Past Master Ferriday Masonic Lodge # 390, Monroe Scottish Rite Bodies and a Noble of Monroe Barak Shrine Temple-Monroe, LA, he served the Concordia Parish School Board 1965-1967 and the Sewer District Board from 1992-2008.

He was preceded in death by his parents Garrett and Allie Greer, daughter, Kay Greer, a brother and a sister.

He is survived by his wife Rachel D. Greer of Ferriday, LA; two sons, BJ Carlin and his wife Marilyn and David Sikes and his wife Sasha, all of Woodworth, LA; seven grandchildren and three great grandchildren.
