Mildred Bynum Edmonds, 85, passed away at her home on January 25, 2012 at 9:30 a.m. She was surrounded by her loving family.

Mildred was born in Mississippi on July 22, 1926, to the union of John Bynum and Flora McIver Bynum. She graduated from Prentiss High School and received her teaching degree from the University of Southern Mississippi. She was a member of the First United Methodist Church of Sicily Island.
