Randy Layne Bond, age 60, of Lafayette, Louisiana passed away Thursday, September 10, 2015, at his residence. Randy was born on September 1, 1955, in Ferriday, Louisiana to the union of Howard W. Bond and Lucille Hudnall Bond.

He was a 1973 graduate of Block High School in Jonesville and received his Bachelor of Science degree in Nursing from Northeast Louisiana University in 1977. He later earned a Master of Science degree in 1997 from the University of Southwestern Louisiana. During his professional career he worked at both the Lady of Lourdes Hospital and at Lafayette General Hospital where he was head nurse of neurology for seventeen years.
