Storm Cangemi was born October 9, 1993 in Ferriday, LA and passed away Thursday, December 17, 2009. He was a resident of Vidalia. He attended Vidalia High School where he was the class president, most likely to succeed, in the gifted program and a member of the student council. He was a member of the Ridgecrest Baptist Church.

Storm had a love for his family, friends, and animals. He truly loved spending family time with his Dad, Mom, brother Cole and sister Katie.
